Then I would not be put to shame when I consider all your commands.



The Church's Law

PRECEPTS



- To attend Mass on Sundays and Holy days of Obligation and to abstain from work that could impede the sanctification of such days.
- To confess sins at least once a year by celebrating the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

CATECHISM

OF THE CATHOLIC CHURCH

- To receive Holy Communion at least during the Easter Season (From Holy week to Pentecost Sunday)
- To observe the prescribed days of fasting and abstinence a time of penance to prepare for special liturgical celebrations. (usually Ash Wednesday and Good Friday)
- To help provide for the needs of the Church.
