


UNIT 2 IMAGES OF GOD

They will come back to live in my shade; they will grow wheat again, they will make the vine flourish, their wine will be as famous as Lebanon's.


HOSEA 14:8

ISAIAH 66:12


I shall fall like dew on Israel, he will bloom like the lily and thrust out roots like the cedar of Lebanon.
