





Our celebration of the Eucharist incorporates a variety of words, signs, symbols, and actions. One of these symbols is colour. Liturgical colours symbolize the character of the different feasts and seasons of the Church year. These colours are used primarily in the priest's sacred clothing (vestments). They are also used on banners and other church decorations.
